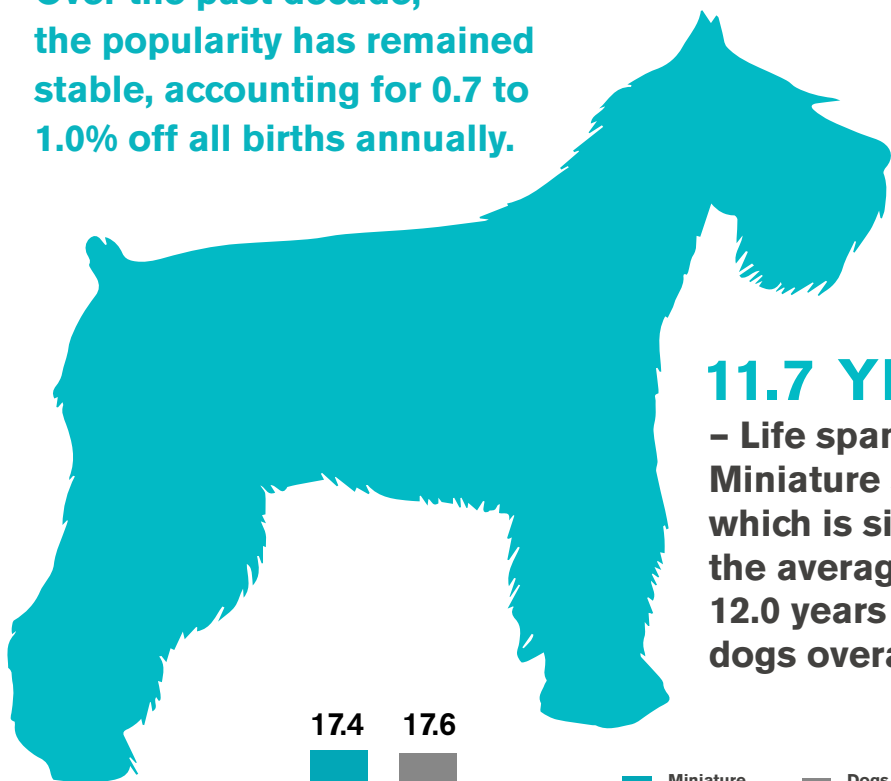


Miniature Schnauzers

This study evaluated the demography, longevity and common disorders of Miniature Schnauzers in the UK.

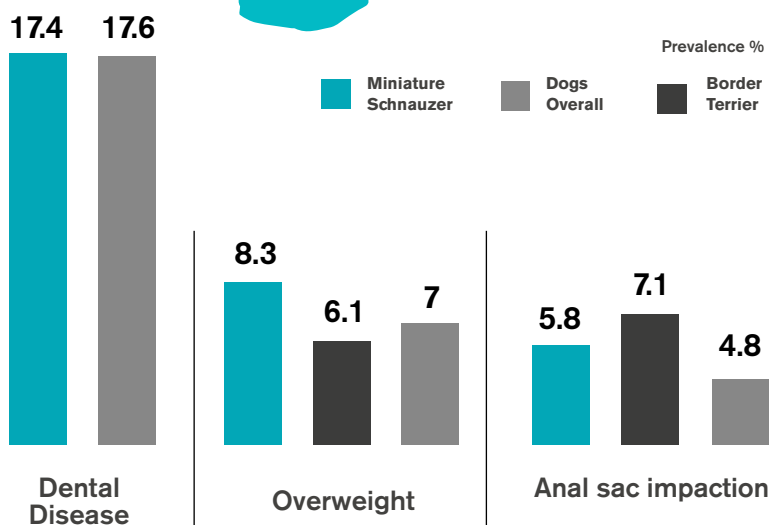
Over the past decade, the popularity has remained stable, accounting for 0.7 to 1.0% off all births annually.



11.7 YEARS

– Life span of a Miniature Schnauzer, which is similar to the average of 12.0 years for dogs overall.

Top disorders within Miniature Schnauzers compared to dogs overall and Border Terriers



CONCLUSIONS

The Miniature Schnauzer does not appear predisposed to any common disorders.
